DOUBLE IRONY

Luke 15:3-4 "Then Jesus told them this parable: 'Suppose one of you had a hundred sheep and loses one of them.

Does he not leave the ninety-nine in the open country and go after the lost sheep until he finds it?'"

How are we doing, as God's people, about reaching out to the lost sheep? Jesus certainly was concerned for them. In the parable the shepherd left the ninety-nine and went after the one lost sheep. He kept looking until he found it and brought it safely back. Is the church doing the same thing? It doesn't seem as though we are when we look at where the church's money is spent. We spend 90% of the funds on Christians and only 10% on reaching the lost. Are we more concerned about our building than we are in reaching souls for Christ?

We can't all become missionaries and go to the countries where these people live. But we can all pray and intercede for the lost.
